Overview & School

Founded in 1980 to educate the employees of Ford, American School of Valencia (ASV) has grown from its initial 27 students to educate more than 740 students from nursery to grade 12. ASV offers three comprehensive college preparatory Diploma programs: US Diploma, Spanish Diploma, and International Baccalaureate. Many of our Spanish students enrolled here at the age of three and our international students often come for just a few years. The ASV Profile of the Graduate based on the IB Learner Profile unites the school community with a common set of attributes to which we inspire to realize in all our students with a particular focus on fostering international-mindedness.

Accreditation

American School of Valencia is fully accredited by Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools (MSA) and the Ministry of Education in Spain. In addition the school was authorized by the International Organization Baccalaureate (IBO) to offer the IB Diploma program in 2004. The school is also affiliated with the Mediterranean Association of International Schools (MAIS), European Council of Independent Schools (ECIS) and The Association for Supervision and Curriculum Development (ASCD).

Student Body/Faculty

The American School of Valencia's student body is approximately 90% Spanish with 10% of its students coming from more than 29 countries. The high school faculty is truly international with teachers from the United States, Canada, Italy, the United Kingdom, and Spain. The teacher/student ratio is approximately 10-1, with classes ranging from 26 students to independent studies taught for 1 student.

University Entrance

The majority of the student population remains in Spain for their university studies. Every year, a small percentage of the students enroll in highly competitive universities in the US, Canada, and Europe. In 2013 and 2014, the school received the highest results on the Spanish University Exams in the province of Valencia. 100% of our graduated students continued their studies in different universities.
